Car parking is available on a Sunday morning at the Suffolk New College car park in Rope Walk.

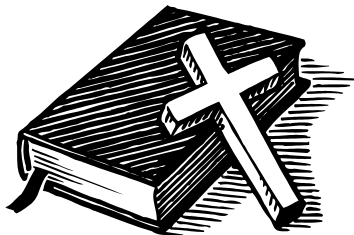
Children & Young Peoples Activities
