

# Holy Trinity Church, Ipswich

(Back Hamlet / Fore Hamlet / Bishops Hill Ipswich)

This is a list of all of the inscriptions on gravestones, tombs and memorials in the grounds of, and in the main Church at Holy Trinity Church in Ipswich. The Church is near the old Ipswich Docks and was built in 1835 by Rev John Thomas Nottidge.
